SpaceSolutions' Disc Compactor: New Carousel Storage System

PLEASANT HILL, Cal. — Compact Discs are stored in compact spaces with a new carousel storage system by SpaceSolutions.

The new Disc Compactor offers a space-saving and stylish alternative to the existing rack and tower systems on the market today, said Douglas Gaus, company president.

"I've followed CD storage

for a long time and I felt nothing addressed it properly," he said. "These days, compact storage of CDs is a problem."

SpaceSolutions' new system is designed to hold the greatest number of CDs in the smallest amount of space, according to Gaus. The round deep unit can hold up to 50 CDs, including double CDs. The patent

is pending for the configuration.

While it won't nearly reach the heights of towers, three units can be stacked to hold up to 150 CDs. Each unit spins independently when stacked and measures 7.5 inches high by 14.5 inches wide.

Another unique feature of the unit is its slotless design, allowing for easy organization and reorganization of music collections. If a row is not full, sliding dowel "bookends" hold CDs upright.

The product's high quality black lacquer finish and solid construction makes it suited for distribution through upscale retailers and catalogs, Gaus said. Currently shipping, it is suggested at \$69.99 and has placement in a West Coast retail chain.
